



The Junior Performing Arts Scholarship is open to all candidates commencing Year 7 in the next academic year irrespective of family income. Candidates must submit this Application with supporting documents by the closing date advertised on the College website. Candidates will then be shortlisted for an audition.

The audition date is advertised on the College website.

Candidates who have been shortlisted will be contacted for an audition one week prior to the audition date.

Dance: An initial group dance choreography session set by the Dance teachers. Those candidates shortlisted as a result of the group dance choreography session will then be invited to perform an individual audition which will consist of two 1 min 30 sec contrasting pieces. The candidate will be required to bring her own music and wear an appropriate dance costume, leotard or dance shorts and top. Both the group session and individual call backs will happen on the same day.

Drama: A prepared monologue of not more than 5 minutes duration chosen by the candidate.

Music: A performance of two contrasting pieces on the major instrument, sight reading and an aural skills test.

The Junior Performing Arts Scholarship will cover **all** or **part** of the **tuition fees** while the candidate continues to study Performing Arts and support extracurricular ensembles at the College. The Scholarship will be subject to an annual review of the candidate's commitment.

Recipients of a scholarship are required to study the subject in which they have been awarded the scholarship as an elective subject in Years 7 to 10 when offered.

These scholarships are based on

- Previous performance experience
- Performance demonstrated at the audition
- Knowledge of music/dance/drama theory will also be considered along with letters of recommendation
