#### **Providing a Term's Notice**

Local families are reminded that the College requires one term's notice of any move to another school or learning environment (NB overseas enrolments require two terms' notice). There are several reasons for this notice period. Firstly, budgets are set on current numbers, and, as the annual budget is set in September, we need to ensure that we are calculating costs and student numbers accurately. Secondly, once school returns in January, we are unlikely to make up numbers lost for any students who choose to leave without providing the required notice.

Please ensure that if your daughter is leaving Stella Maris at the end of 2021, you have informed the Registrar by the end of Term 3.

#### Semester Break

As I mentioned last newsletter we have installed solar panels on the roof of the Theatre. There are 109 panels which will be producing 61.4 megawatt hours of power per year, avoiding approximately 55 tons of carbon every year. As a comparison this system would be able to power the equivalent of 11 Australian homes; take 19 cars off the road; and power over 307 school computers. We already have solar panels on the Scholastica wing and will plan for additional panels as part of our next masterplanning project. 

There's a lot of things 'not happening' right now but learning at Stella is always happening!


