## Dear Stella Community

#### Term 4

A letter has gone out this week to outline some of the plans for our return to school. Key to this plan is to first to ensure that our Stella staff are safe and vaccinated. Plans for the return of students hinge on this factor and we are striving to ensure that all our staff are safely double vaccinated before the planned return of students.

We are very excited to see the students returning to school. A consideration for parents/carers is that students should travel safely to and from school. The government is recommending that parents drop their children at school rather than use public transport. Importantly, we know that following this recommendation will cause heavy congestion around lluka and Eurobin Avenues so I ask drivers to be patient and cautious, to obey No Stopping signs and to mindful of our neighbours driveways. Options to streamline drop off include doing so slightly earlier or in a street slightly further from the College.

#### Year 12

As you would realise the Year 12 cohort are keen to complete their studies and I am heartened by the bravery of this cohort. Plans for finishing at the end of Term 3 had to be put aside as their HSC exams were delayed. These girls, however, took on the challenge bravely and maturely.

The Year 12 girls realised that in the HSC they present as a cohort (not as an individual) and that they are only as academically good as the strongest and the

weakest student in the group. These girls knew that their results could be improved if they all worked together to gain a greater understanding of their subjects so they could produce even better examination results in their HSC. Shunning sunning themselves on the beach or taking up some extra shifts at their workplaces, they have put the needs of their Stella sisters first and continued to work with their teachers on their studies. I am very proud of their efforts!

#### **Facebook and Instagram**

This week the Wall Street Journal has stated that Facebook's own research indicate that spending time on Instagram has a detrimental effect on the wellbeing of some adolescents, particularly girls. Facebook also found that Instagram amplifies negative body image concerns for one in three teenage girls.

According to Facebook's own research, 32 per cent of teenage girls said that when they felt bad about their bodies, Instagram made them feel worse, and 40 per cent of Instagram users who felt "unattractive" said that this feeling was caused by using the app. Internal Facebook documents also show that 13.5 per cent of teen girls say that Instagram makes their suicidal thoughts worse and 17 per cent believe it makes their eating disorders

Frances Haugen, a data scientist for Facebook, has 15 years experience working for tech companies. This week she fronted a United States congressional hearing to put forward the view that Facebook knows that Instagram is problematic for girls.

The minimum number of children to attend is 6 with no maximum numbers (up to 50 can be catered for). The price is \$80 per child. The minimum age is 5 years and again no maximum as all ages enjoy the parties and they are designed for the age group booked.

The fun filled 1.5 hours includes the children hand tempering chocolate on marble and making a selection of chocolates – all of which they take home on the day in generous goody bags (so you do not have to create these yourself!). The children make chocolate bars, artwork lollypops, chocolate stars and freckles (this can be adjusted or changed on request).

You can choose to use organic milk, white or dark chocolate. You will need to make the selection before the event. All children get a certificate, celebrating the day. The birthday parties usually are hosted 2-3.30 on Saturdays and Sundays but other days and times can be booked if we have availability.



We offer a full high tea service after your party for an additional \$40pp. Please note our high tea is an outdoor event only.

Alternatively there is a lovely BBQ area that many parents have a party and cake at after. Please note the BBQ area is a public facility, so we recommend you get there early to try to get the space. Our front lawn is an excellent alternative to bring a picnic rug and watch the boats sail by on the harbour foreshore while enjoying your cake.

If you would like our balcony with tables and chairs and plates for the cake; this space can be leased for 1 hour for an additional \$150 per hour. This way you can have full access to our harbourside outdoor deck to celebrate with cake and snacks that you bring on the day.

Please note we are a fully licensed venue, so can serve adults sparkling wine and champagne at this time. For BYO we charge an overall \$25 corkage for the hour. Please advise us if you are bringing alcohol on the day.






