## Dear Stella Community

### Term 4

Ms Yeates and Ms Smith have sent home information regarding the gradual return to the classroom, ensuring that all students and staff are kept safe, following the strict COVID-safe guidelines. We appreciate the strong support we have had from our Stella families and the feedback on vaccinations among students, which has been helpful in creating our risk assessments for the return to school.

With regard to staff vaccination, I can reassure parents that by 25th October, 100% of Stella staff will be double vaccinated. There was some quick rescheduling of appointments when the NSW government decided to fast track the return to school but we are very pleased that all staff have been able to organise their full vaccinations by the new start date.

Strict safety measures will remain in place at school with sanitiser, social distancing, cross ventilation in classrooms and mask wearing for all the community.

### Year 11

This week we had speeches from the students who will make up our Senior Leadership Team for 2022. I was so proud of the girls and their deep understanding of who we are as a Good Samaritan Benedictine school. All the girls could articulate the Benedictine values of peace and justice, community, hospitality and stewardship, that underpin our ethos, and could express how these values impact on their actions in the community. I know that the leaders who will be chosen will lead the community well. Thank you to Ms Heraghty and Mr Jones for organising the leadership training and co-ordinating the speeches.

## Geography News

### My neighbourhood is my classroom

During Terms 3 and 4, Years 8 and Year 9 Geography classes were given opportunities to undertake local fieldwork during lockdown. The restrictions meant that we have had to cancel our local in-class and full day fieldwork opportunities. The Geography Team at Stella were not deterred and, where possible, we integrated local fieldwork during class time to complement our lessons. Year 8 upcycled their items at home and are currently investigating the liveability of their local neighbourhood by taking photographs, completing a liveability evaluation task and analysing their results.

Year 9 assessed the sustainability of their local neighbourhoods by constructing field sketches and taking photos to compare their local area with megacities around the world. Last term, Year 8 Geography finished their unit on Fast Fashion by upcycling items in their homes in an endeavour to reduce waste going to landfill. Below are some images of their unique creations.

The Scholarship covers the tuition fee component of the annual student fees for Year 11 2022 and Year 12 2023 and is subject to an annual review of commitment and performance. The Scholarship does not cover the cost of resource fees or any other non-tuition fees.

**Auditions will be held in the week beginning 15th November.**

Once applications are closed, a short list of successful applicants will be invited for an audition. Those successful in the audition will be called for an interview.

With the fluid Covid restrictions at the moment we may require applicants to submit a video of their performance if we are unable to audition in person. Applicants will be informed of the audition process closer to the audition date.

Applicants are to prepare the following for their audition:

- Music – an accompanied performance on their principal instrument. Backing tracks or live accompaniment are acceptable.
- Dance – a prepared solo in preferred style.
- Drama – a short monologue (no longer than 2 minutes).

Alternatively there is a lovely BBQ area that many parents have a party and cake at after. Please note the BBQ area is a public facility, so we recommend you get there early to try to get the space. Our front lawn is an excellent alternative to bring a picnic rug and watch the boats sail by on the harbour foreshore while enjoying your cake.

If you would like our balcony with tables and chairs and plates for the cake; this space can be leased for 1 hour for an additional \$150 per hour. This way you can have full access to our harbourside outdoor deck to celebrate with cake and snacks that you bring on the day.
