Assembly

This week our Year 12 2022 Leadership Team led their first assembly marking UNESCO's International Day of Non-Violence which is observed on the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, leader of the Indian independence movement and pioneer of the philosophy and strategy of non-violence. Establishing a culture of peace and sustainable development are at the heart of UNESCO's mandate.

The world has seen much violence in the last decade. Violence continues in the Middle East, North Africa, and Sub-Saharan Africa, with Afghanistan, Iraq, Nigeria, Somalia, and Syria, bearing the heaviest burden. Sometimes it can feel as if there is little that we can do to respond to this.

The #KindnessMatters Campaign aims to mobilize young people to carry out transformative acts of kindness to create a positive culture that abhors violence. The world today is home to 1.8 billion young people - the largest generation of youth in history. What an opportunity is there to show leadership by being kind to one another.

Catholic Earthcare is a program of Caritas Australia that helps to promote understanding that our world is sacred, endangered, and must be protected and preserved for present and future generations. Students and teachers from Catholic schools across Australia connected through Zoom to interact with many special guest speakers regarding the climate crisis and other environmental matters.

Meningococcal Vaccination Year 10



NSW School vaccination clinic, Year 10 students, Friday 19th November 2021

NSW Health will be offering the following vaccinations at your school clinic to all Year 10 students;

Year 10 - Meningococcal ACWY

What parents should do

Year 10 parents/guardians have been sent (via their Year 10 student) a *Parent Information Kit* that includes an information sheet, consent form and privacy statement. To consent to the vaccination of their child, parents/guardians are advised to read all the information provided, complete the consent form, and return it to their child's school.

- Ensure that students with influenza-like symptoms do not attend school and are tested as soon as possible (www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/symptoms-and-testing)
- advise the Public Health Unit MSLHD-SchoolVaccinationProgram@health.nsw.gov.au to withdraw consent for HPV, dTpa or MenACWY vaccination if any of these vaccines have been given at the GP
- o note that there is a minimum dosing interval of 7 days between any routine school vaccinations (HPV, dTpa and Meningococcal ACWY) and any dose of a Covid-19 vaccine

All parents are asked to provide an up to date copy (downloaded no more than 7 days prior to the school clinic) of their child's Australian Immunisation Record (AIR). This can be on their child's phone (if your school allows student phones to be accessed during school hours) or a paper copy the student brings to the vaccination clinic. (If parents prefer, provide the record for vaccines given in 2021 only.) It can be obtained through the myGov website or the Express Plus Medicare Mobile app. Anyone aged 14 years or older has to get their own statement.

This is required so the nurses can quickly and easily check that all students are vaccinated safely and appropriately on the day of the school clinic.

Absent students

Year 7 students will be offered any missed doses at subsequent clinics during Year 7 or 8 (for HPV and dTpa vaccination) and do not need to go to their GP for the vaccine.

Absent Year 10 students can also be seen at the next school clinic on 8/12/2021 for vaccination.

A Record of Vaccination card will be provided to each student. Details about vaccinations given at school will also be uploaded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).

NSW Health is ensuring that students are safely vaccinated at school during Covid-19

Despite concerns around Covid-19 it is important that the school vaccination program continues, to provide timely protection against other diseases. NSW Health has been working with education authorities to implement additional measures to ensure that students in Year 7 and 10 can be safely vaccinated during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Additional measures implemented include; nurses vaccinated against Covid-19, health screening of nurses and students before entering the clinic, appropriate physical distancing, enhanced hand hygiene and cleaning measures.

The minimum number of children to attend is 6 with no maximum numbers (up to 50 can be catered for). The price is \$80 per child. The minimum age is 5 years and again no maximum as all ages enjoy the parties and they are designed for the age group booked.

The fun filled 1.5 hours includes the children hand tempering chocolate on marble and making a selection of chocolates – all of which they take home on the day in generous goody bags (so you do not have to create these yourself!). 




