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Principal's Update



What to do when the excitement of starting back in 2022 has gone

As a school staff we have been reflecting on the impact of the last two years on learning, as we were challenged by COVID-19 and a lack of connection within the college community. The summer break was important to take stock, but for teenagers, setting up good routines and getting back into the challenge of day-to-day, face-to-face schooling takes grit and persistence.

Some teens look for opportunities to avoid - to avoid perceived conflict, to avoid completing tasks, to avoid social situations, to avoid being challenged in the classroom. It is important that we, as parents and teachers, respond quickly before patterns of school avoidance become a problem.

Create a back-to-school plan

I was speaking with a student on Monday about her mismatched socks and she mentioned she only had five minutes to get out the door or she'd miss the bus. Getting ready for school starts the night before, ensuring that uniforms are ready, bags are packed and computers are charged. As a parent, you can help by checking in to see if this has been completed before your daughter goes to bed.

Help your child be more connected

If your daughter is struggling with a sense of connection to the school, please reach out to her PC Teacher and her Head of Year. Your daughter will be encouraged to get involved in activities at school to make those connections with like-minded students.

Encourage your daughter to set up opportunities to connect on the weekend or after school with other students. Building a broad network of peers will help her develop those connections and offer her a sense of belonging.

Plan transitions from home to school

Collect some calming kinaesthetic items or an App for their phone (like Smiling Mind) to assist with the trip from home to school. A plastic fidget toy might be worth the investment.

What if these strategies don't work?

If these strategies don't work, please connect with an Educational and Developmental Psychologist to help identify any deeper concerns that need to be addressed. Be patient and never give up. There is always progress that can be made with persistence.

**The Stella Swimming Carnival is a compulsory school day
for all students in Years 7 to Year 12.**

Time

All students should be at school by 8.40am for PC. Students will walk to the pool in PC groups. All students are required to walk back to Stella at the conclusion of the carnival and will be dismissed from school at 3.20pm.

What to wear

All students will need a one-piece swimming costume and house coloured swimming cap. You may purchase these from the uniform shop.

This year's theme is UNDER THE SEA!

Students are encouraged to wear house colours in the theme of the day! No singlet tops or inappropriate length shorts. Covered shoes must be worn for the walk to and from the pool.

Other important information

- There will be no canteen on the day
- Bring a hat and plenty of sunscreen
- No coloured hair spray or coloured streamers allowed at the pool
- Students must remain in their seating areas when they are not competing. The indoor pools and children's pools are out of bounds.
- Normal school rules apply for the day.
- Parents will receive an email to give permission on Consent2Go.

There is no scheduled lunch break. Students are encouraged to bring their own healthy snacks and lunch for the day. **THERE IS NO CANTEEN AVAILABLE FOR THE STUDENTS THIS YEAR.**

The Events

There will be two divisions of races:

- Championship and
- Non-Championship.

To be considered for age champion or the Stella swimming team, you must compete in the Championship event for that stroke.

Entries for the Championship events opened on Monday 21 February and close on Tuesday 1 March.

All students have been sent a link to a survey to enter the Championship races they would like to compete in. (Link will also be on the sport notices on SEQTA). The age group is the age that you turn this year.

Students who do not want to enter championship events will be able to enter non-championship races on the day. Ribbons will be awarded in both championship and non-championship events. You do not need to pre-register for non-championship events.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT ALL STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE.

You can only swim each stroke and distance once. For example you cannot do 50m championship freestyle and 50m non-championship freestyle. However, you may do 50m championship breaststroke and 50 non-championship freestyle.

Student Health Care Plans and Medications

The medical health of your daughter is important to us.

Please ensure all Health Care Plans and medication is recorded in Consent2Go.

Any prescription or over-the-counter medication held onsite must be in date.

You may be contacted to replace any expired, or soon to be expired medication(s).

Use of Mobile Phones

We ask students and parents to familiarise themselves with our **Acceptable Use Protocols for Mobile Phones**. We limit device time to encourage students to create new relationships, build connections and be involved in a range of school activities.

Student refusal to follow guidelines may result in confiscation of the mobile device which can be collected from their Head of Year at the end of the school day.

COVID-19 Isolation Protocols

Where your daughter is a **positive case** she must remain in isolation for 7 days as per the NSW Health Guidelines. Your daughter can return to face-to-face learning 7 full days (24hrs x 7) after testing positive, and no symptoms present.

If your daughter is a **household contact** she must remain in isolation for 7 days as per the NSW Health Guidelines. Your daughter can return to face-to-face learning **after the person who has tested positive** has completed 7 full days (24hrs x 7) of isolation and providing she has no symptoms present.

If feeling well at home, your daughter can continue her classes by remote learning, checking for her work in SEQTA.

Absences

We remind our parent/guardian community to notify the College of student absences by **8:00am** or earlier where possible.

Advise the name of your daughter, reason for absence and expected return date.

In this current COVID-19 climate, some medical absences may require further explanation of symptoms.

This will enable our Student Services Team to notify class teachers of your daughter's absence and maintain accurate records.

Early Exit

We understand there are times students need to leave before the official end of the school day.

We require parents to notify Student Services.

The student will need to obtain a Leave Pass to present to their teacher to leave their lesson.

Before exiting the grounds, the student must officially check-out at Student Services.

Lost Property

We often have school jerseys, jackets, scarves, wireless devices and other items handed into Lost Property. Many items cannot be returned to the student as they are unlabelled.

We ask that personal items be labelled so they can be returned to the student.

Late Arrivals

Where students arrive late for school, the student is required to visit Student Services to explain reason for late arrival. Parents may be contacted for verification purposes.

Kiss and Drop Zone

A reminder students can be dropped or collected from school at the designated Kiss & Drop Zone located in Iluka Avenue. Please park responsibly and avoid obstructing neighbouring driveways.

P Plate Drivers

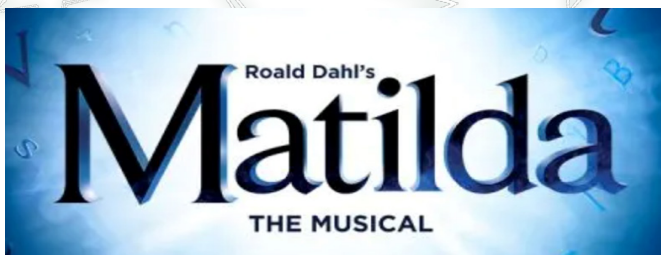
