St Scholastica

February 10 is the feast day St. Scholastica, the twin sister of St. Benedict, the "father of monasticism" in Western Europe. The twins were born around 480CE to a Roman noble family in Nursia, Italy but sadly the twins' mother died at their birth. When Benedict was old enough he left home to study in Rome leaving Scholastica with her father to tend the Nursian estate. In time, Benedict left his studies to live first as a hermit, and then he founded communities of monks in Italy, following The Rule of St Benedict.

When Scholastica learned of her brother's total dedication to the Lord, she was determined to follow his example. It is not certain that she became a nun immediately but it is believed she founded a monastery of nuns near one of her brother's monasteries. The brother and sister communities were about five miles apart. St. Benedict seems to have guided his sister and her nuns, in the practice of the same rule by which his own monks lived. Upcoming Traffic Disruptions

We have been advised that the NSW SLS Championships are taking place at Queenscliff SLSC from 24 February thru to 13 March.

With 5,000 competitors expected every day, it is predicted there will be heavy traffic congestion at the following times and locations (Competition days):

Pittwater Rd at Kierle Park/Hinkler Park (Dog park on Pittwater Road)

24 - 27 February

between 5:30am - 8:30am & 3:00pm - 5:00pm

2 March - 6 March

between 5:30am - 8:30am & 3:00pm - 5:00pm

Hinkler Park, Kierle Park as well as Lagoon Reserve will be utilised for competition parking on event days.

It is expected there will be increased traffic flow towards Hinkler Park, along Collingwood Street and Eurobin Avenue throughout the entire Championships.

If feeling well at home, your daughter can continue her classes by remote learning, checking for her work in SEQTA.

Once the isolation period has been completed, a negative RAHT result is returned and no symptoms present, your daughter can return to school for face-to-face learning.

NSW School Vaccination Program

Each year NSW Health works in partnership with schools to offer the vaccines recommended by the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) for adolescents as part of the school vaccination program.

In 2022 the following vaccines will be offered:

Year 7

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine 2 doses at least 6 months apart

Year 7

Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis Vaccine (Whooping Cough) 1 dose

Year 10 Meningococcal ACWY Vaccine 1 dose

Parent Information Kits that include an information sheet, consent form and privacy statement will be sent home to parents/guardians. To consent to the vaccination of your child, parents/guardians are advised to:

- read all the information provided;
- complete the consent form, including signing your name next to the vaccine/s you would like your child to receive;
- return the completed consent form to school.

Parents please ensure:

- your daughter eats breakfast on the day of the school vaccination clinic;
- your daughter does not attend school with any symptoms of COVID-19.

Absent students:

Please note that to improve vaccination completion, students will be opportunistically offered a catch-up vaccination for any missed doses, including:

- during Year 8 (for HPV and Tpa vaccination) for consent signed in 2021;
- during Year 11 (for Meningococcal ACWY vaccination) for consent signed in 2021.

Any catch-up vaccination will be done on the same day as Year 7 and Year 10 clinics.
They do not need to go to their GP for the missed vaccine.

Parents/guardians who later on wish to withdraw their consent after they have handed in the consent form can do so by writing to the Principal or phoning the school. The Procedure for Withdrawal of Consent is available on the NSW Health website.

A Record of Vaccination will be provided to each student vaccinated at each clinic as a physical card. Details about vaccinations given at school will also be uploaded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) to support complete vaccination histories. Parents can obtain this through the myGov website or the Express Plus Medicare Mobile app (anyone aged 14 years or older has to get their own statement).

At present lunch orders **must be ordered online.** Unfortunately we are unable to accept orders sent via email or over the telephone.

We ask that all online orders be placed no later than

8:00am each day

using your My Student Account accessible from the Stella Online College Portal

We ask you not to place orders for more than 24 hours in advance as there are occassions where stock may have been consumed and is no longer available.

Please ensure your daughter has available funds on her Student Account. Insufficient funds will result in the order not being processed.

Currently we are able to sell drinks, snacks and ice-creams from outside the canteen after lunch orders have been given out. We are not allowing walk-ins during Recess or Lunch at this time.

If your daughter has special dietary requirements, please notify us so we can make every effort to accommodate her needs.

Absences

We remind our parent/guardian community to notify the College of student absences by 8:00am or earlier where possible.

Advise the name of your daughter, reason for absence and expected return date.

In this current COVID-19 climate, some medical absences may require further explanation of symptoms.

This will enable our Student Services Team to notify class teachers of your daughter's absence and maintain accurate records.

Early Exit

We understand there are times students need to leave before the official end of the school day.

We require parents to notify Student Services.

The student will need to obtain a Leave Pass to present to their teacher to leave their lesson.

Before exiting the grounds, the student must officially check-out at Student Services.

Lost Property

We often have school jerseys, jackets, scarfs, wireless devices and other items handed into Lost Property. Many items cannot be returned to the student as they are unlabelled.

We ask that personal items be labelled so they can be returned to the student.

Late Arrivals

Where students arrive late for school, the student is required to visit
Student Services to explain reason for late arrival.
Parents may be contacted for verificaiton purposes.

Kiss and Drop Zone

A reminder students can be dropped or collected from school at the designated Kiss & Drop Zone located in Iluka Avenue. Please park responsibly and avoid obstructing neighbouring driveways.
