## National Cross Country

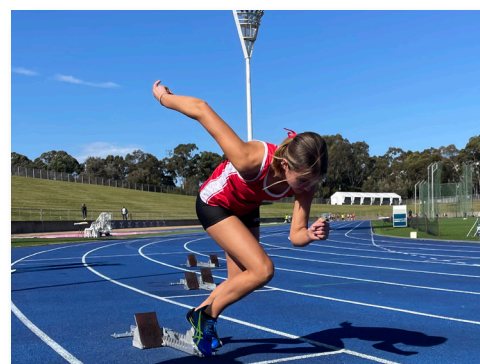
Congratulations to Pip Q and Lyla R (Year 7) who represented NSW School Sport at the Australian Cross Country Championships in Adelaide from 27 – 29 August. Both Pip and Lyla were selected into the NSW team after winning their age groups at the NSW All Schools Championships in July. Lyla and Pip performed amazingly well in Adelaide!

Pip Q **WON the GOLD MEDAL** in the U14 event! She is now Australian Champion – an amazing achievement!

Lyla R also competed in the U14 event. She finished 16th overall in this race, but was the FIRST 12 year old to finish – so technically, first in Australia in her age group!

From their great results in the cross country race, both Pip and Lyla were selected into the NSW relay team to compete in the teams event in Adelaide. The NSW team went on to win the GOLD MEDAL!
