The Stella Charity Mufti Day and Cake Stall is an educative opportunity for students to gain a deeper insight into the complex realities that cause people to experience homelessness. The Stella Charity Mufti Day and Cake Stall is the culmination of several weeks of work in Pastoral Care lessons and Year Meetings. The aim has been to gain a deeper understanding of the realities faced by people experiencing homelessness and to raise funds to support action to end the cycle of violence and poverty that contribute to this persistent situation in our local and international communities.

The funds raised will go directly towards supporting:

- The Vinnies Winter Appeal
- Jesuit Refugee Service
- The Bacolod Kinder school in the Philippines

Why are we asking for funds?

- To raise money to purchase food vouchers from Coles and Woolworths for the Vinnies
 Winter Appeal and the Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS). There have been several requests from
 organisations in our local community seeking support through food donations due to the stress
 and impacts of the cost-of-living crisis right now.
- We will also donate money to the Sisters of the Good Samaritan Outreach ministry in Bacolod, The Philippines, to help support and sustain the kinder school's nutritious milk and breakfast feeding program this is critical for these most vulnerable people that literally have nothing and try to survive hand to mouth each day.
- Friday 8 September will be the Charity Mufti Day \$10 is payable through Consent2Go.
- · Please encourage the girls to donate baked cakes / muffins for the cake stall on the Friday.
- A gold coin donation to purchase a cake / muffin or gelato is required on the day.




Year 12 HSC Music Evening Jessica Maker - Head of Performing Arts
